DAY 1

MORNING ADVENTURE

BRYCE CANYON NATIONAL PARK

Bryce Canyon National Park is the big attraction for Bryce Canyon Country, attracting millions of visitors each year. The park has a \$35 entrance fee per vehicle that lasts up to seven consecutive days — so keep your receipt! There are various lookouts, hikes and opportunities for exploration throughout the park. We've listed a few below. To enter the park and avoid parking, take the [Bryce Canyon Shuttle](#).

- **The Rim Trail:** The trail most traveled, this popular trail overlooks the national park as it stretches across the landscape with many other branching trails for exploration along the way. For easy access, there is a half-mile section of this trail between Sunrise and Sunset Point that is paved for wheelchair accessibility. This is dog-friendly as long as you stay on the paved areas of the trail and pets stay on a leash.

LUNCH: BRYCE CANYON PINES

Location: Scenic Byway 12 — Utah's All-American Road, Mile Marker 10, Bryce Canyon, Utah

Bryce Canyon Pines is a local favorite and a popular place for visitors as well. The business takes pride in the hearty meal offered from delicious home-cooked meals including soup, pie and cowboy-size steaks to mashed potatoes and gravy. The company even has world-famous homemade soups and pies. In fact, its pies were recognized as among the "Best of America." Try the local favorites banana blueberry or banana strawberry pie.

AFTERNOON ADVENTURE

CANYON 2 CANYON TRAIL

View the hoodoos and red rock vistas of the area in a new way. This trail is paved for the entire length and starts at the west entrance of Red Canyon. It runs for more than 6 miles past towering hoodoos and stunning red rock formations along Scenic Byway 12.

DINNER: EBENEZER'S BARN & GRILL

Location: 110 E. Center St. Bryce Canyon City

Make the most of your getaway with dinner and a show at Ebenezer's Barn and Grill. Ebenezer's serves up authentic cowboy BBQ with a side of live country-western music. You'll want to be in your seats by 7:20 p.m. for dinner at 7:30 p.m. and the start of the show at 8:00 p.m.! The house band — the [Bryce Canyon Wranglers](#) — will blow you away with their original, award-winning song "Helluva Place To Lose A Cow" about Bryce Canyon.

LODGING: BRYCE CANYON INN

Location: 21 North Main, Tropic — Located just off Scenic Byway 12

Only open during the summer season from March to October, cabins 21, 22 or 23 are pet-friendly at Bryce Canyon Inn. Each cabin includes a fridge, microwave, cable television, bathtub/shower combo, in-room coffee, comfy beds and free Wi-Fi. Laundry facilities along with The Pizza Place, Bryce Canyon Coffee Company and the Bryce Canyon Horse Motel are also on the premises.

MORNING ADVENTURE

KODACHROME BASIN STATE PARK

Visitor Center Location: Kodachrome State Park Rd, Henrieville

Kodachrome Basin State Park is known for its 67 monolithic stone spires, called sedimentary pipes. They have been shaped and accentuated from multi-hued sandstone layers that reveal 180 million years of geologic time. The color and beauty found here prompted a National Geographic Society expedition to name the area Kodachrome, after the popular color film, in 1948. Not to mention, the park just became a certified International Dark Sky Park in 2021.

- **Panorama Trail Long Loop:** This moderate, 5.8-mile hike is dog-friendly as long as pets are on leashes.
- **Panorama Trail:** If you don't want to take the whole loop, this easy, 2.9-mile trail is an option.
